



Nerve Plexus:


network of nerves formed by the spinal





Cervical & Brachial Plexus






Brachial Plexus & Intercostal Nerves

Innervates lateral side of forearm


Median Nerve

Ulnar Nerve Innervates medial side of forearm




Lumbar & Sacral Plexus


LUMBAR PLEXUS

Lumbar Plexus Nerves




Runs right across femur


Lateral Femoral Cutaneous

thigh


Obturator Nerve Innervates medial thigh


Saphenous_ Nerve


Innervates medial side of femur all the way to the medial ankle
