



External Observations

- Look for the umbilical cord
 - Try to find the umbilical arteries/veins that connected its blood supply to mom via the placenta
- External nares (remember what those are?)
- Tongue




External Observations


- Boy or Girl?
 - Look under the tail.
 - Find anus (hole)
 - Look below anus...
 - if you see a SMOOTH swollen sac of skin – you have found the SCROTUM and you have a male!
 - If you an obvious folded area of skin. You have found the GENITAL PAPILLA and you have female!




Diaphragm

 The Diaphragm looks like a "flap" of muscle that hangs over the liver and stomach The diaphragm attaches to the body wall and separates the abdominal cavity from the lung (pleural) and heart (pericardial) cavities. Contraction of the diaphragm forces air into the lungs.






More Diaphragm



Larynx/Trachea/Neck Vessels



Common Carotic Artery


Internal - Jugular Vein






